GUIDE TO THE TRADE UNIONS AND LABOUR PARTY DIRECTORY FOR CLP LIAISON OFFICERS

The TULO Directory is designed to be useful to a wide range of people; but it is a particularly useful tool for Trade Union Liaison Officers in CLPs.

One of the most difficult things about being a CLP Liaison Officer is knowing who to contact in each of the unions' varied structures to get the information, contacts and support you need. We hope that the Directory will be an invaluable resource for you, and will be a helpful starting point for much of the work that you will want to do in your role.

The Directory should be used in conjunction with the Trade Union Liaison Officer's Handbook, which is an in-depth guide to the role of the CLP Liaison Officer, and gives detailed practical advice for undertaking a range of activities to strengthen the link between the Labour Party and its affiliated unions at a local level.

We want to ensure that the TULO Directory is as accessible and easy-to-use as possible, so we have provided this short introductory guide for CLP Liaison Officers on how to begin to use it. However, whilst it will provide a useful basis for your activities, the TULO Handbook is also essential reading. How the TULO Directory can help you

The Directory is likely to be useful to you in a variety of ways: knowing who to contact in unions at a local or regional level, or how to get in touch with the Officers of the TULO Committee in your region will come in handy on many occasions.

This introductory guide is not going to map out all of the different ways you might need to use the Directory – that's what the Handbook is for – but we have identified two key ways in which you might want to start using it: in putting together a pool of local union contacts, and in increasing union affiliations to your CLP.

Creating a database of local union contacts

The vast majority of your local activities will hinge upon having a comprehensive database of local union contacts. Much of this information can be gathered from existing CLP knowledge and experience – speaking to your MP, and the Officers of your CLP to find out about what links already exist between the CLP and unions, and anecdotal information about who comes to meetings and

what historical relationships there have been will be an important place to start in building a picture of the local situation. The TULO Handbook will provide much more information about how to do this.

Once you have gained an understanding of the CLP's existing links with trade unions, you will need to build a picture of the local structure of the unions. This will not be an easy task, as no two unions are the same, and the geographical regions that they operate within vary from union to union. Similarly, the unions' branch structures also vary – some have branches tied to large workplaces, some to a number of workplaces, some have sector-based branches, and others may have no branches in your constituency at all.

You will need to use the TULO Directory to contact each union's regional office to ask them for a list of branches sitting within your constituency's boundaries, and for the name and contact details of their Full-Time Officers with responsibility for those branches. Gaining this information will not be easy and may take time – unions' main concern is serving their members' interests, and providing this information to you might well be given lower priority – be prepared to follow up with letters and phone calls and chase information to complete your database.

Once you have assembled this database, it will be of great use to you in a number of activities. From organising a trade unionists' social, to

mobilising union activists at election time – knowing who your local contacts are is essential.

Affiliations to your CLP

The union contacts database, together with the TULO Directory will also be of great use in increasing union affiliations to your CLP. You will need to begin by liaising with your CLP Secretary to find out which union branches already affiliate, and identifying where the gaps are.

Once you have ascertained where the gaps in branch affiliations are, you will need to consult the TULO Directory to find out where to go next. The unions have varied structures for managing and funding branch affiliations to CLPs. In some unions, the power and budget for affiliations rests with the branches, in others it is decided at a regional level, and in certain unions the authority lies in the national political office.

Knowing this information is essential in being able to target your invitations to affiliate at the right level. Each union has their own page in the TULO Directory, outlining how they manage their local affiliations. Use this information, combined with the contact details for regional and national offices, and the local database of contacts that you have put together, to write to the appropriate contact to invite local branches to affiliate to your CLP. The TULO Handbook provides more information about affiliations, including a model letter of invitation.
