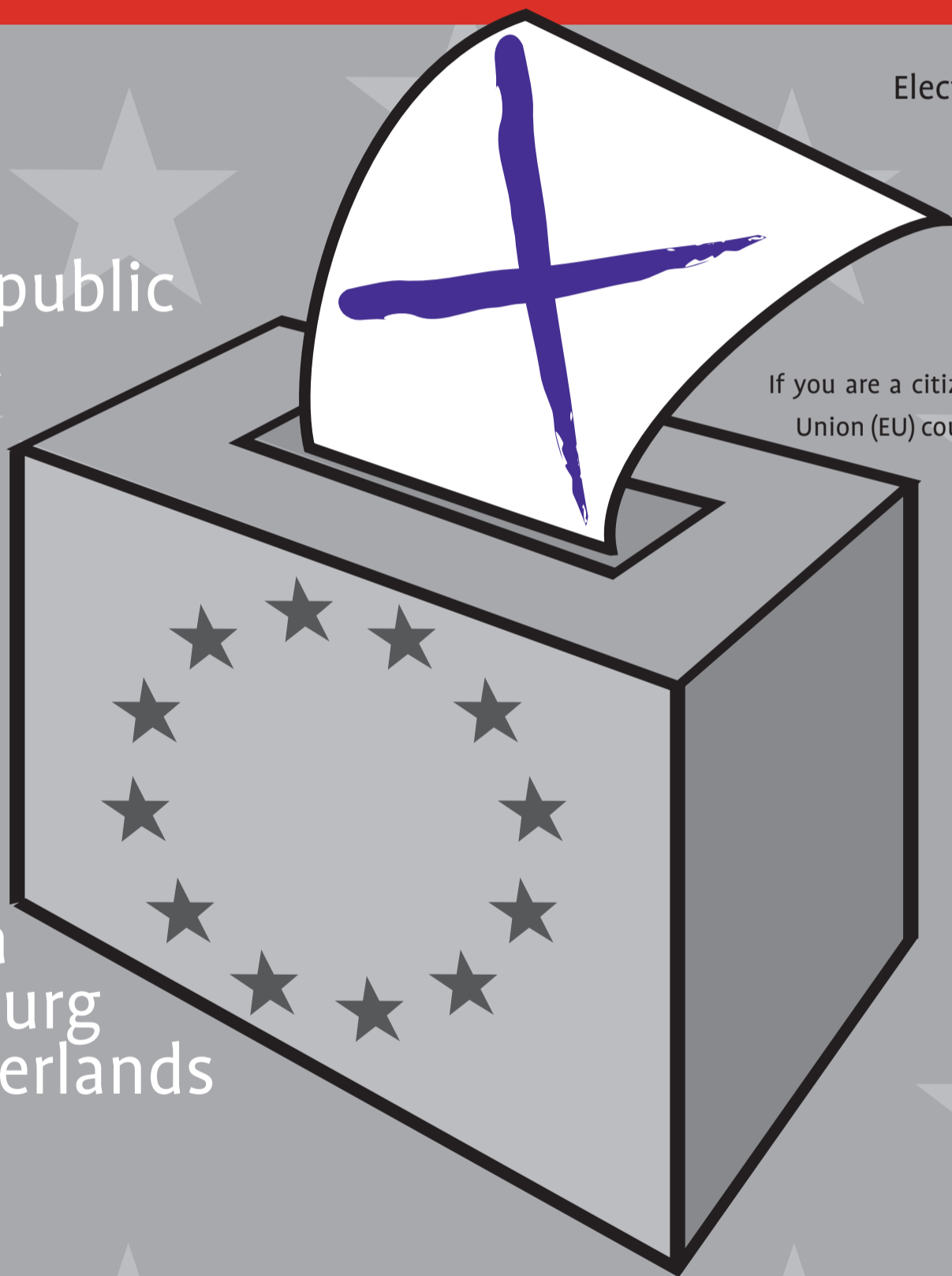


# European Union Citizen?

Register to use your vote in the European elections this year

Elections to the European Parliament take place every five years, and the next election will be on 4 June 2009.

If you are a citizen of one of the European Union (EU) countries listed below, you can register to vote in the UK at a European Parliamentary election, but you will need to sign a declaration that you are only casting a vote in the UK. This will not affect your right to vote in other elections in your home country.

If you are a citizen of the UK, Republic of Ireland, Malta or Cyprus, you are eligible to register to vote at all UK elections and so do not need to sign a declaration, but make sure that you are registered to vote.
